## Garanti Bank is the only Turkish company listed in the Dow Jones Sustainability Index

Garanti Bank became the only Turkish company to qualify for the Dow Jones Sustainability<sup>TM</sup> Emerging Markets Index.

Having qualified for the BIST Sustainability Index and the BIST Corporate Governance Index last year, Garanti proved once again that it successfully integrated sustainability into all of its activities and banking operations by further qualifying to be a member of the Dow Jones Sustainability<sup>TM</sup> Emerging Markets Index.

The Dow Jones Sustainability<sup>TM</sup> Emerging Markets Index is composed of emerging-market sustainability leaders as identified by RobecoSAM through a corporate sustainability assessment. The index aims to represent the top 10% of the largest 800 companies in 23 emerging markets based on long-term economic, environmental and social criteria.
